

Annual Parish Meeting held at the Village Hall on Tuesday 17th May 2016 at 8.30p.m.

Present: Councillors, B. Nelson (Chairman), Mrs. E. Bradshaw, V. Game, Mrs. S. Howgill, A. McArdle, L. Roberts, Mrs.K. Rowan, K. Granger (Clerk) and two members of the public.

Cllr. Nelson said the reports from the various clubs and organizations were spread on the table at the side of the hall. He had already circulated a report to email subscribers and he would use that report as his text for the meeting. He went on to say the parish council had done more with less precept money because we had sought funding from other sources, our total expenditure last year had been £23,000 and that we had made a big effort to keep in touch with parishioners through all 4 notice boards, our web-site, which last year had 10753 views from all over the world, Facebook and Twitter as well as several hand deliveries to all in the Parish.

Cllr. Nelson went on to say our draft NP was hoped to go before the parish in the autumn and thanked those who had worked so hard on this over the last 2 yrs. or so and that we are represented on the committee which has the job of implementing super-fast broadband in Devon & Somerset. The Trustees of the new hall are to be congratulated on its existence and we as a parish council are trying to secure land for extra car park use.

The Chairman went on to thank all the club/organizations for the work they have done during the last 12 months and in some cases many years, their experience and support for the community is very much appreciated by the Parish Council. Lastly but not least he thanked all Councillors for their voluntary time and hard work for the parish, much increased with the production of the Neighbourhood Plan.
